### Living Out The Truth

God revealed Himself to us in His Word that we might know the Living God and live in Him. The Word of God is intended to change what we do, say and think. It is from the Word of God that our faith in God is strengthened. It is not enough that we simply read the Bible, or even memorize it. For real spiritual success, we need to meditate on scripture so that the Spirit of God can show us what He would have us to do. If you will engage the Spirit of God by asking Him questions of the inspired text, He will direct you into truth and empower you to live out your faith. As an example, the following questions will be helpful as you meditate on God's Word:

#### General Questions of Application – From This Passage...

1. Are there any **attitudes** I ought to acquire, delete, or change?
2. Are there any **actions** I ought to avoid, follow, or modify?
3. Are there any **sins** I ought to confess and forsake?
4. Are there any **examples** I ought to follow or not to follow?
5. Are there any **commands** I ought to obey?
6. Are there any **promises** I ought to claim?
7. Are there any **prayers** or **praises** I ought to voice?

#### Questions Based on The Profitability of Scripture – 2 Timothy 3:16-17

##### Profitable for Doctrine

1. What does this passage teach me about God, about the world of people, about the world of things, or about myself?
2. What does this passage teach me about God's relationship to man (unsaved, believer) – or about my relationship to God and others?

##### Profitable for Rebuke

1. What does this passage teach me about how/why I may have failed?
2. What does this passage teach me about sin and temptation?

##### Profitable for Correction

1. What does this passage teach me about what must take place to mend my relationship with God and my fellow man?
2. What does this passage teach me about bringing my life back in line with God's Word and will?

##### Profitable for Instruction in Righteousness

1. What does this passage teach me about how I may live a life pleasing to God?
2. What does this passage teach me about Godliness?

<b>IV. Application – How Does It Work?</b>	What light does other portions of scripture shed on this passage? What does this truth look like when put into practice?
